



## **2019 College Scholarship Application**

**The Quatrefoil Library College Scholarship is a one-time, \$1,000 scholarship open to all high school seniors or college students who are/will be attending college within the State of Minnesota. Quatrefoil is one of the country's oldest and largest LGBTQ lending libraries and also serves as a community center.**

### **Quatrefoil Library Mission**

At Quatrefoil Library, our mission is to collect, maintain, document and circulate gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender and queer materials and information in a safe and accessible space.

### **Scholarship Requirements and Information:**

- Anyone who meets the criteria below is eligible to apply. Quatrefoil does not and shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion (creed), gender, gender expression, age, national origin (ancestry), disability, marital status, sexual orientation or military status in any of its activities or operations.
- \$1,000 scholarship to a graduating high school senior or college undergraduate
- Limited to students enrolled at/planning to attend a college (including vocational or technical) or university in the State of Minnesota.
- Applicants must have current cumulative high school or college GPA of 3.0 or above.
- Preference will be given to applicants enrolled in a liberal arts (such as literature, history, gender/sexuality studies, philosophy, mathematics or social and physical sciences) bachelor or similar program.
- Applications must be postmarked no later than July 1, 2019.
- Successful scholarship candidates will demonstrate quality academic performance shown through a combination of grades and involvement; be a proven leader in their school, community or peer group; and demonstrate sincere commitment to some form of community service or helping others.

Applicants will be notified in August 2019.

- Sealed official high school or college transcript (Please do not send separately.)

- Well-written, typed essay of no more than 500 words describing how you plan to use the scholarship to further your education and answering the question “**Why am I pursuing this degree, and how would this scholarship and the resources of Quatrefoil Library help me in reaching my goals and my future endeavors?**”
- Two current and original letters of recommendation within the past year. (Photocopied and/or undated recommendations will not be accepted.)
- Name and address of school where check would be sent if awarded (No checks will be issued directly to students).
